



AFTER THE DISASTER

The best time to prepare for an emergency is before it happens. Print out this checklist and keep a copy in an easy-to-reach location for immediate reference.

Reporting To Work

- ❖ Listen to the radio to receive possible citywide reporting instructions:
 - KFI (640 AM)
 - KNWZ (970 AM)
 - KNX (1070 AM)
 - KNWH (1240 AM)
 - DES (104.7 FM)
- ❖ Contact your immediate supervisor in your chain of command to receive reporting instructions
- ❖ Follow the procedures for reporting to your normal work location or designated Staging Area.
- ❖ Be sure to have your employee identification card with you. It may be required to rapidly access emergency transportation routes.

Getting to Work

- ❖ If possible, follow your normal transportation route, i.e. driving and/or public transportation
- ❖ If your transportation routes are obstructed, use alternate routes
- ❖ In the event that transportation routes are not available, the City and County will coordinate with RCOE on emergency transportation for DSWs

Collection points to such facilities as:

- ❖ Alternate RCOE sites
- ❖ Vital City Control/Communication Sites
- ❖ Fire Stations
- ❖ Police Stations
- ❖ Major Healthcare Facilities
