**Background Information:** Mosaica Online Academy Charter petition for renewal was denied by the Nuvview Union School District governing board. The petitioners have submitted their petition to the Riverside County Board of Education on appeal of the district denial of their renewal.

The Public Hearing was held pursuant to Board Policy 0421.41 and Education Code section 47605(j)(1) on February 12, 2014 as a part of the Riverside County Board of Education meeting. At its March 12 meeting, the Riverside County Board of Education will render a decision on Mosaica's appeal.

2. **ACTION ITEM 2- COMMON CORE STANDARDS PLAN ADOPTION**

**Background Information:** AB 86 was signed by Governor Brown on July 1, 2013, to provide one-time funds for the implementation of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). That amount is estimated to be approximately \$200 per student and is to be spent in 2013-14 and 2014-2015 school years. This contribution will support each district's charge of preparing students for college and career and for the adoption of CCSS. As a condition for receipt of the funds, each local educational agency must develop and adopt an expenditure plan detailing how the funds will be spent. The plan was reviewed February 12, 2014 at the Riverside County Board of Education meeting.
