Subject: Notice of Violation - Imagine Schools, Riverside County

Background Information: RCOE staff has identified violations of the Imagine Schools, Riverside County Charter that, unless successfully remedied, may serve as a basis for possible revocation of that charter. Prior to revocation, a chartering authority must notify the charter school of the identified violations and provide the charter school with a reasonable opportunity to respond to and/or remedy the violations. (California Education Code § 47607(c); 5 CCR § 11968.5.2.) If, after a reasonable opportunity, the school does not successfully remedy the violation(s), the chartering authority may move forward with revocation proceedings by providing the charter school with a written Notice of Intent to revoke and notice of facts in support of revocation. A chartering authority may not revoke a charter unless it makes written findings supported by substantial evidence.
