Subject: Riverside County Expelled Student Plan – Triennial Update

Background Information: On or before July 1 of each year, county boards of education are required to hold a public hearing and approve the annual budget of the county superintendent of schools. The Riverside County Superintendent of Schools has certified as positive the 2014-2015 Second Interim Report. A positive certification indicates that based upon current projections the Riverside County Office of Education will meet its financial obligations for the current year and two subsequent fiscal years.
