The Riverside County Office of Education Foundation (RCOEF) was founded in 2013 by dedicated community leaders, education professionals, and RCOE staff. There was an acute awareness that Riverside County students were in need of additional opportunities to help them graduate from high school and pursue their college education and career goals. The primary need was financial assistance to offset the challenges of economically disadvantaged households. Thus, the **Student Scholarship Program** was conceived and implemented to address this challenge. To date, the Foundation has awarded over \$218,000 in scholarship funds and continues to increase that number each year. The Riverside County students who have received scholarship assistance are attending schools of higher education such as, UCLA, USC, UC Berkeley, UC San Diego, UC Davis, Cal State Long Beach, Cal State Northridge, Riverside City College, Moreno Valley College, and Mt. San Jacinto College.

RCOEF is continually looking to increase our fundraising efforts to support our scholarship program and other RCOE student advancement programs.
