She supports the California Department of Education on a range of topics related to access and equity for culturally and linguistically diverse students and was a lead author of California's current *ELD Standards, ELA/ELD Framework, Practitioners' Guide for Educating English Learners with Disabilities, and Arts Standards*. She was the co-editor of the recent book *Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Learners and STEAM Education: Teachers and Researchers Working in Partnership to Build a Better Path Forward*, available through Information Age Publishing.

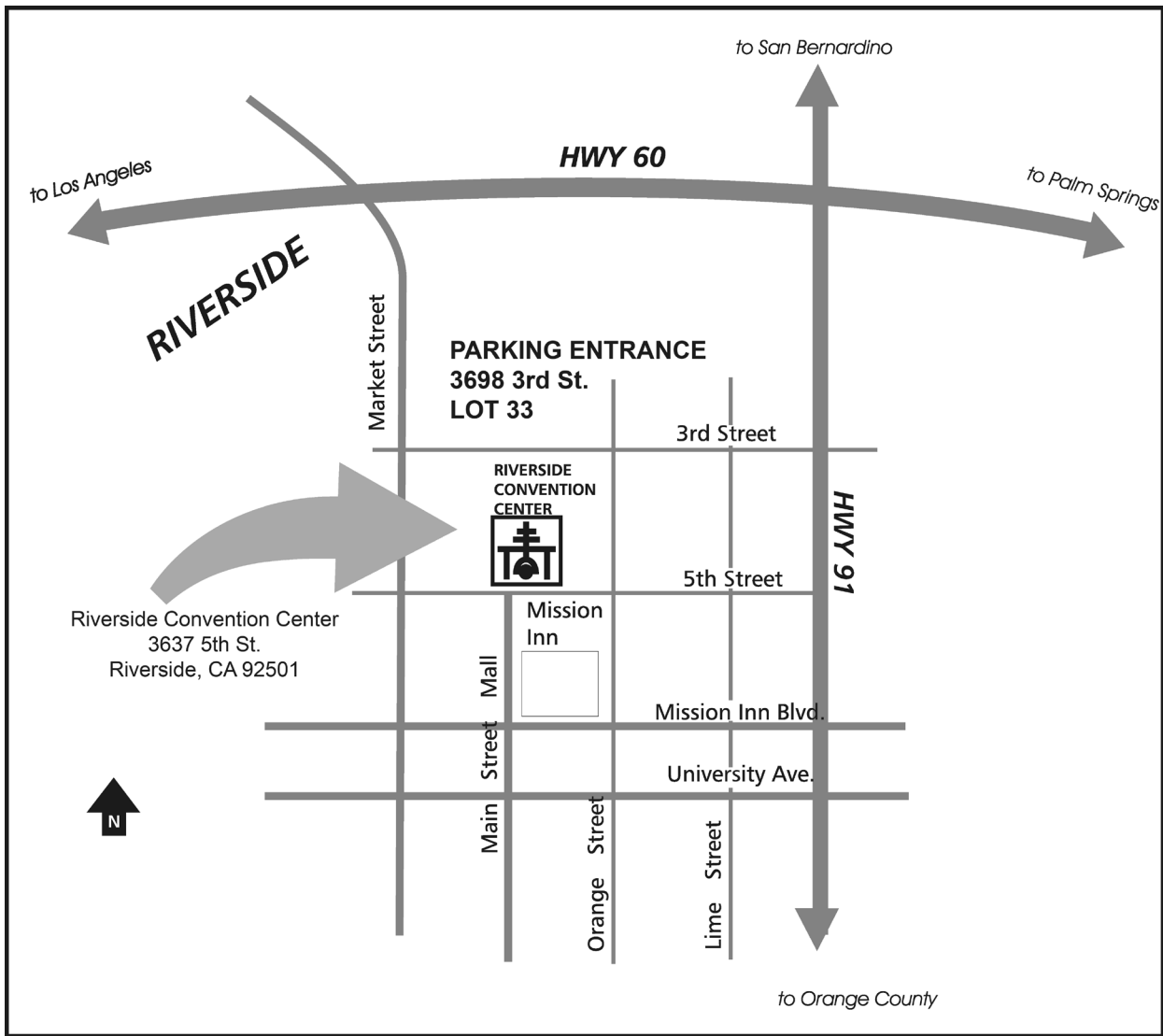
