



PBIS/MTSS Universal – Tiers 1 & 2

Join our virtual PBIS/MTSS Tier 1 & Tier 2 Team Training to support district and school site teams in strengthening a comprehensive Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) through the implementation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS). Teams will build the systems, data, and practices needed to create safe, positive, and predictable learning environments for all students while strengthening targeted supports for students who need additional instruction, feedback, and intervention. Participants will explore how Tier 1 and Tier 2 systems work together to integrate school mental wellness, social-emotional learning, culturally responsive practices, and data-based decision making. Training will be offered at two levels—Year 1 and Year 2—to support schools at different stages of implementation. All trainings will be presented virtually.
