Through structured dialogue and reflective protocols, participants will strengthen their capacity to use data with clarity and purpose, ensuring that decisions are aligned to college and career readiness outcomes and equitable access for all students. This session emphasizes intentional planning, coherence across sites, and actionable next steps that can be implemented and monitored over time. This is part one of a two-part series, with part two consisting of individualized follow-up sessions to refine and support implementation of the service plan.

AVID Center COP: AVID Elective Level 1 – Implementing the Fundamentals of Instruction (Two-day Training)

This two-day Community of Practice is designed for middle and high school educators serving as new AVID Elective teachers at new or existing contracted secondary sites. It is also intended for AVID Site Coordinators who are new to teaching the AVID Elective; coordinators in this role should complete Elective Level 1 prior to attending Site Coordinator Level 1.

This offering is reserved for first-time participants or educators who have not completed AVID Elective Level 1 (or its equivalent) within the past five years, ensuring alignment with current curriculum resources, instructional expectations, and updated AVID methodologies.

Grounded in a Foundational Learning Journey, participants will engage deeply with the AVID Weeks at a Glance curriculum, including tutorial implementation, and develop fluency in research-based Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization, and Reading® (WICOR®) strategies. Emphasis is placed on establishing strong instructional routines, cultivating student agency, and building coherent systems that promote rigor and college and career readiness.

Through collaborative planning, reflection, and application, educators will leave with a clear implementation roadmap and the confidence to deliver the AVID Elective with fidelity and purpose.

## Secondary DEMO School Planning and Support Workshop

The Secondary AVID National Demonstration School (NDS) (Re)Validation Workshop walks middle and high schools through the step-by-step validation and revalidation process aligned to the Secondary Implementation Tool (SIT). Participants learn what to expect before the visit by completing the SIT and gathering evidence across the four AVID Schoolwide Domains—Instruction, Systems, Leadership, and Culture. The workshop explains what occurs during the validation visit, including classroom observations, student and staff interviews, and systems review. It also outlines what happens after the visit, including feedback and determination. Schools leave with a clear understanding of the (re)validation process and expectations for sustaining strong AVID implementation. This workshop is designed for the entire AVID site team to plan together.

## AVID Center COP: AVID Elementary Implementation Grades PreK–2 (Two-day Training)

This two-day Foundational Community of Practice is designed for primary educators who are new to AVID implementation in grades PreK–2. Participants will explore essential strategies, structures, and resources that establish the groundwork for strong schoolwide AVID systems in the early years.

Educators will deepen their understanding of their role within an AVID schoolwide framework and examine how intentional modeling, encouragement, and integration of Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization, and Reading® (WICOR®) strategies cultivate the academic behaviors and mindsets students need for long-term success. Emphasis is placed on developmentally appropriate practices that build language, ownership, organization, and collaborative skills beginning in the primary grades.

Through collaborative dialogue, structured reflection, and practical application, participants will leave with clarity on implementation expectations and a plan for embedding WICOR® strategies into daily instruction in ways that align with sitewide goals and a coherent college and career readiness vision. This course is intended for educators who have never taken AVID Elementary Implementation: PreK–2. The training may be repeated after five years; however, priority registration is reserved for first-time participants to ensure access for educators new to implementation.

The focus remains on creating classrooms where every student can meaningfully engage with complex content while building the literacy skills necessary for long-term academic success.

## AVID Center COP: Academic Language and Literacy – Asset-Based Instruction for All Classrooms (Two-day Training)

Academic Language and Literacy Community of Practice is designed for educators who support multilingual learners and students developing academic language across grade levels and content areas, with a particular focus on integrated English language development settings. This experience is especially valuable for AVID Excel sites in their first year of implementation, with a recommendation to send at least four content teachers representing math, history or social science, science, and English language arts (ELA).

Participants engage in asset-based instruction that integrates the four domains of language: reading, writing, speaking, and listening, into rigorous, scaffolded lessons. Grounded in the AVID College and Career Readiness Framework, the learning emphasizes diagnostic teaching and collaborative routines that strengthen student voice, agency, and access to complex content. Differentiated experiences are embedded throughout the Community of Practice to ensure relevance and support for educators across all grade levels and disciplines, fostering intentional planning and aligned instructional practices that advance language development and academic success.
