Foster Youth Services Coordinating Programs (FYSCP) were established in 2015 to help county offices of education improve outcomes for foster youth through interagency collaboration and capacity building. Each FYSCP forms a local Executive Advisory Council (EAC) with members from local/tribal welfare and probation departments, the courts, and other key stakeholders. The EAC identifies service needs, coordinates efforts to reduce redundancy, and aligns with local control and accountability plan priorities.

Riverside County Office of Education's FYSCP EAC includes district liaisons, community, county, and post-secondary partners, and student voice. The FYSCP Annual Needs Survey distributed to the EAC helps us better support our foster youth and amplify services. The EAC is a voting council. For example, it may vote on grant-related changes or meeting logistics.

We are excited to kick off the 2026-27 year with our first meeting on September 2, 2026.
