General Information

- Parking at the Riverside Convention Center is complimentary.
- Students must check in during the appropriate times on the schedule of events.
- After check in, students will proceed to their assigned project display table and set up their display.
- RCSEF officials will visit each project before 8:30 a.m. to ensure that safety and display regulations outlined in the Riverside County Science and Engineering Fair Guidelines beginning on page 9 are met.
- Parents may assist their students with setting up their projects. After 8:30 a.m., only authorized judges, students, and RCSEF officials are to be on the judging floor.
- A light snack will be provided to students at the first break. The Convention Center concession stand will be open for parents and guests waiting for students.
- The awards ceremony will be held on Wednesday, April 3, 6 p.m., Riverside Convention Center Exhibit Hall A-B.
- A **maximum** of two gold medals and a maximum of five silver runner-up medals will be awarded, as deemed appropriate by judges, in each category for Grade 4, Grade 5, Junior Division, and Senior Division. One sweepstakes award will be presented in each division (Grade 4/5 combined, Junior Division, and Senior Division). Community awards will also be presented during the awards ceremony. If a student is not present at the awards ceremony and they receive a medal, the medal will be sent to the affiliate fair coordinator to give to the student.
- Certificates of participation will be provided to every student. Students will pick up their certificate when they place their project on Tuesday, April 2.
- No projects are to be removed on Tuesday, April 2.
- All projects must be removed by 8:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 3 or immediately following the end of the awards ceremony. Projects are to be signed out in the foyer on the upper level of the Convention Center.
- The decision of the judges is final.
